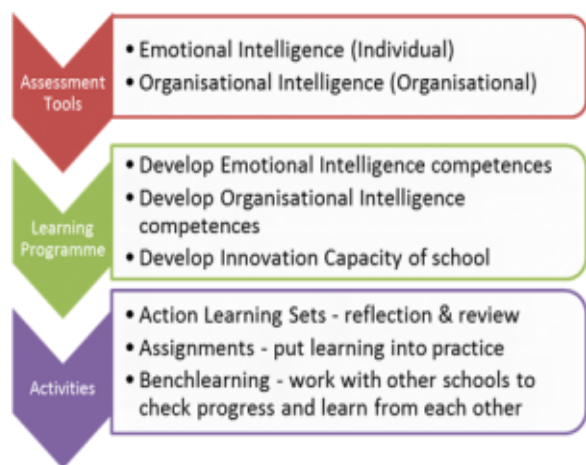




# Helping schools overcome resistance to change

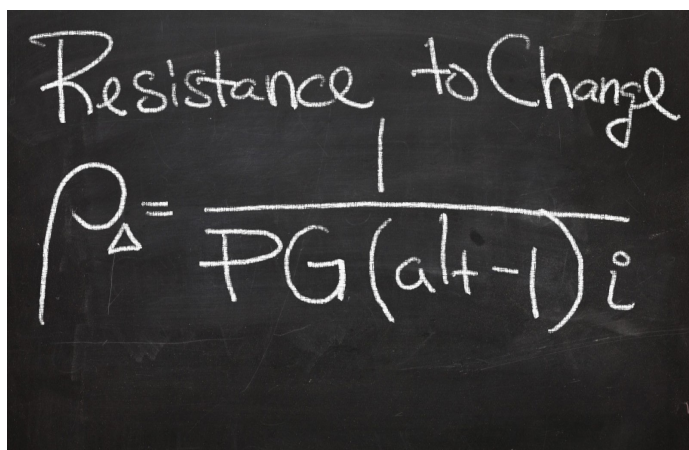
